This survey is for the Affirmatively Furthering Fair Housing (AFFH) plan, a document that the City of Brockton is preparing as required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

The Federal Fair Housing Act prohibits discrimination in housing on the basis of race, color, national origin, religion, sex, familial status and disability. In Massachusetts, the following additional classes are protected: ancestry, age, marital status, source of income, sexual orientation, veteran history/military status and genetic information (M.G.L. Chapter 151B). The AFFH seeks to identify barriers to fair housing,

The AFFH process will begin with inclusive community participation and will result in the setting of fair housing goals to increase fair housing choice and provide equal access to opportunity for all community members. The City of Brockton will then use the fair housing goals and priorities established in the AFH to inform the investments and other decisions made in their local planning processes. If you have encountered a barrier to renting or buying a home you may have experienced housing discrimination.

This survey is being used to determine conditions present in the community. Your input is greatly needed. Please feel free to share and distribute this survey with friends and family who reside or work in Brockton, or surrounding communities.
