CDBG Applications FY2020

Thank you for your interest in applying for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), July 2020 through June 2021 funding cycle. The purpose of the CDBG grants are to improve the community economically, socially, and physically. These applications are for Public Service funding and/or Public Facility improvements. Please note that funding is not guaranteed to any applicant, despite prior funding. Applications will go through a risk assessment and matrix grading that includes reviewing application strength, risk assessment score, community need, and ability to perform necessary grant requirements. Please note that this year's application includes some slight changes, with additional organizational documents to be provided that have not been requested in the past. **All applications are due promptly at 3:00pm on Friday, March 20, 2020 with a physical original signature and an electronic copy.**

In order to assist in the application process, we are holding an information session on Wednesday, March 4, 2020 in the downstairs conference room at the Metro Chamber of Commerce at 60 School Street, Brockton. The information session will begin at 2:30pm with an approximately twenty (20) minute presentation and forty (40) minutes for questions and discussions. Our annual meeting is to follow immediately after, beginning at 3:30pm, which all subrecipients are encouraged to attend. Staff is always available for questions during business hours via email, phone, or scheduled one-on-one meetings.

To save time and money for the community, please fully read the funding guidelines, attend the information meeting on the application process, and submit only complete applications.
